POLICY ON CASH PRIZES / ENDOWMENTS

Padmabhushan Vasatraodada Patil Mahavidyalaya, Kavathe Mahankal, Dist Sangli, is dedicated to fostering academic excellence and recognizing outstanding achievements among its students. As part of this commitment, the institution has established a policy for awarding cash prizes to students who achieve the first and second positions in their respective departments. These prizes are funded through donations made by teachers upon their retirement from the institute.

STATEMENT:

The Cash Prize Policy aims to honor and reward students for their exceptional academic performance. This policy ensures that the process of awarding these prizes is transparent, fair, and encourages a culture of academic excellence.

AIMS:

1. To recognize and reward students for their academic achievements.
2. To motivate students to strive for excellence in their studies.
3. To utilize the generous donations of retiring teachers to support and inspire current students.
4. To promote a culture of academic rigor and dedication within the institution.

OBJECTIVES:

1. To identify and honor the top-performing students in each department.
2. To provide financial rewards to students who achieve the first and second positions in their respective departments.
3. To ensure the fair and transparent allocation of cash prizes.
4. To inspire all students to excel in their academic pursuits.

PROCESS:

1. Announcement and Eligibility:

- The institution will announce the cash prize program at the beginning of each academic year as well as in Induction program of first year students.
- All students enrolled in degree programs at Padmabhushan Vasatraodada Patil Mahavidyalaya are eligible to compete for the prizes.

2. Evaluation Criteria:

- Academic performance will be evaluated based on the students' grades and overall academic records.

- The top two students in each department, as determined by their academic performance, will be selected for the prizes.

3. Donation Collection and Management:

- Donations made by retiring teachers will be collected and managed by the college administration.
- These funds will be allocated specifically for the cash prize program.

4. Selection Process:

- The prizes will be distributed in the presence of faculty, students, and invited guests.


6. Documentation and Records:

- A report on the cash prize program will be prepared and submitted to the college management for review.


7. Review and Amendments:

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POLICY ON INSTITUTIONAL SCHOLARSHIPS

Padmabhushan Vasanttraodada Patil Mahavidyalaya, Kavathe Mahankal, Dist Sangli, is dedicated to supporting the academic and extracurricular pursuits of its students. To this end, the institution has established a comprehensive scholarship policy aimed at providing financial assistance to economically disadvantaged students and encouraging participation in sports. This policy outlines the provision and utilization of the Student Aid Fund (S.A. Fund) and the Sports Scholarships.

STATEMENT:

The Institutional Scholarship Policy is designed to provide financial support and resources to students in need and to promote excellence in sports. This policy ensures that deserving students receive the necessary assistance to continue their education and achieve their full potential.

AIMS:

1. To provide financial assistance to economically disadvantaged students for their educational expenses.
2. To encourage and support students' participation in sports at university, national, and other competitive levels.
3. To ensure fair and transparent allocation of scholarships and financial aid.
4. To foster an inclusive environment where all students have the opportunity to succeed.

OBJECTIVES:

1. To identify and support economically weaker students through the Student Aid Fund.
2. To recognize and reward student athletes with Sports Scholarships.
3. To maintain transparency in the disbursement of scholarships and financial aid.
4. To monitor and review the effectiveness of the scholarship programs periodically.

STUDENT AID FUND (S.A. FUND):

I. Collection and Utilization:

- An amount of approximately Rs. 20 is collected from each student to create the Student Aid Fund.
- The collected funds are utilized to assist needy and economically weaker students in paying their educational fees.

II. Eligibility:

- Students from economically disadvantaged backgrounds are eligible to apply for assistance from the Student Aid Fund.
- Applicants must provide necessary documentation to prove their financial need.

III. Application Process:

- Eligible students must submit a written application along with required documents to the college administration.
- A committee will review the applications and recommend the disbursement of funds based on the financial need and academic performance of the applicants.

IV. Disbursement:

- Approved students will receive financial assistance directly towards their educational fees.
- The amount of assistance provided will be determined based on the available funds and the financial need of the students.

SPORTS SCHOLARSHIPS:

1. Scope and Coverage:

- Sports Scholarships are provided to students participating in various sports competitions at the university, national, and other competitive levels.
- Assistance is provided in the form of money, tracksuits, T-shirts, shoes, dietary supplements, caps, etc.

2. Eligibility:

- Students who have demonstrated excellence in sports and are selected to represent the college in competitions are eligible for Sports Scholarships.
- Applicants must provide evidence of their participation and achievements in sports.

3. Application Process:

- Students must submit a written application along with necessary sports participation certificates and achievements to the college administration.
- A committee will review the applications and recommend the disbursement of scholarships based on the sports achievements and needs of the applicants.

4. Disbursement:

- Approved students will receive the sports scholarship in the form of financial assistance and/or sports equipment as specified.
- The type and amount of assistance will be determined based on the available funds and the needs of the student athletes.

REVIEW AND AMENDMENTS:

1. Monitoring:

- The effectiveness of the Student Aid Fund and Sports Scholarships will be monitored regularly by the college administration.
- Feedback from beneficiaries will be collected to assess the impact and identify areas for improvement.


2. Review:

- The scholarship policy will be reviewed periodically to ensure it meets the needs of the students and aligns with the institution's objectives.
- Amendments to the policy, if any, will be made with the approval of the college administration.
