Inventions are possible because of research.

Social problems can be identified and solved.

What is research?

Research is a systematic and scientific investigation of a problem.

It involves a search for new knowledge, interpretation, or verification.

It is a highly intellectual activity.

Stages of academic research

1. Identification of a research problem

2. Review of literature

3. Formulation of objectives / hypotheses

4. Research design and methodology

5. Data collection

Stages of academic research

1. Identification of a research problem

- Choose and clearly define a topic or question

- Hamlet is a tragic hero.
- Why do many P.G. students of English hesitate to speak English in class?
- Plants grow faster in sunlight.
- What factors contribute to graduate unemployment in urban areas?

Stages of academic research

2. Review of literature

Study existing research to understand what is already known.

- What has already been done in the chosen area
- Critical articles, books and research papers
- Journals dedicated to specific fields
- JSTOR, Web of Science, Scopus, Shodhganga

Stages of academic research

3. Formulate objectives/hypotheses

Set aims or testable statements.

- What the study aims to achieve (objectives) or what is to be tested (hypotheses)

- Objectives guide the direction of the study, while hypotheses are testable predictions on the literature review

3. Formulate objectives / hypotheses

- ***Use of symbolism in a novel***

Objective: To analyze the major symbols used in *The Old Man and the Sea* and their meanings

- ***Effect of fertilizers on plant growth***

Hypothesis: Plants given organic fertilizer will grow taller than plants without fertilizer.

- ***Relationship between study habits and academic performance***

Hypothesis: Students who follow regular study schedules perform better in exams than those who do not.

Stages of academic research

4. Research design and methodology

- This explains how the research will be conducted.
- Approach, methods, tools, sample selection, and procedures used to collect and analyze data.
- A clear methodology ensures the research is systematic and reliable.

4. Research design and methodology

- ***Character development in a novel***
The researcher uses qualitative textual analysis, closely reading the novel
- ***Testing water purity***
The researcher uses an experimental method, collects water samples, tests them in a laboratory using chemical indicators, and records measurable results.
- ***Impact of online learning on students***
The researcher uses a survey method, selects a sample of students, designs questionnaires, and analyzes responses using statistical tools.

Stages of academic research

5. Data collection

- Gathering information required for the research.
- The type of data collected depends on the research field and methodology.
- Data may be primary (first-hand) or secondary (already existing).

5. Data collection

- *Themes in a novel*
Example:
The researcher collects data by selecting relevant passages, dialogues, symbols, and themes directly from the literary text and related critical works.
- *Measuring temperature changes*
Example:
The researcher collects data by conducting experiments, taking temperature readings using thermometers or sensors, and recording observations in tables.

5. Data collection

➤ *Study of voting behavior*

Example:

The researcher collects data through surveys, interviews, questionnaires, or official statistics from government records.

Stages of academic research

6. Data analysis

- Data analysis involves organizing, examining, and interpreting collected data to find patterns, relationships, or meanings.
- The methods of analysis depend on the nature of the data and the research discipline.

6. Data analysis

- *Imagery in poetry*
types of imagery (nature, emotional, symbolic) and interpreting their meanings using literary theory.
- *Relationship between income and education*
The researcher analyzes survey data using statistical tools such as percentages, averages, or charts to identify trends and correlations.

Stages of academic research

7. Interpretation of results

- What the analyzed data signifies.
- The researcher connects findings with research objectives, hypotheses, and previous studies to understand their meaning and importance.
- The methods of analysis depend on the nature of the data and the research discipline.

7. Interpretation of results

➤ *Symbolism in a novel*

How symbols represent deeper themes like freedom or oppression and how they support the overall message of the novel.

➤ *Plant growth experiment*

The researcher interprets results by explaining why plants exposed to sunlight grew faster, relating findings to the theory of photosynthesis.

7. Interpretation of results

➤ *Impact of education on employment*

The researcher interprets survey results to explain how higher education levels increase employment opportunities, supporting or rejecting the hypothesis.

Stages of academic research

8. Conclusion and recommendation / results

- The researcher summarizes the major findings, and highlights the significance of the study.
- Recommendations are suggestions or proposals based on the findings of the research.
- They may be meant for future researchers, policymakers, institutions, or practitioners.

8. Conclusion and recommendation / results

- **Topic:** Use of symbolism in *The Old Man and the Sea*
- **Conclusion:**
The study concludes that symbols such as the sea, the marlin, and the lions represent struggle, endurance, and hope, reinforcing Hemingway's theme of human resilience.

8. Conclusion and recommendation / results

- **Topic:** Effect of fertilizers on plant growth
- **Conclusion:**
The research concludes that plants treated with organic fertilizer showed significantly greater height and healthier leaves compared to untreated plants.

8. Conclusion and recommendation / results

- **Topic:** Impact of education on employment
- **Conclusion:**
The study concludes that higher levels of education increase employment opportunities and income levels among urban youth.

Stages of academic research

9. Report writing and publication

- The researcher presents the entire research work in a systematic, structured, and formal manner.
- It could be written as **thesis, dissertation, research paper, or report.**
- It could be also published in journals, books, or online repositories

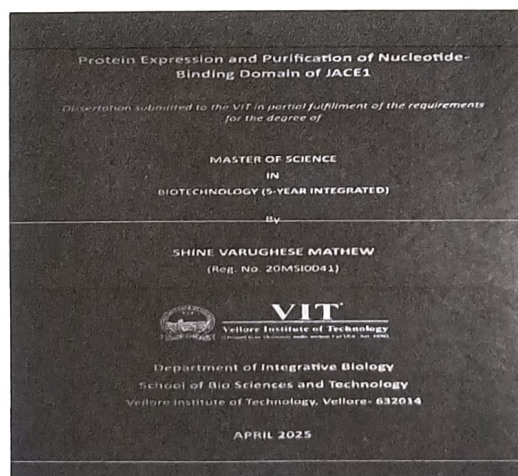

Guidelines for Research Projects
M. Com. II, Sem. IV (6 Credits)

A) For Research Students

1. Project Report shall be prepared by the students **individually** and under the guidance of the concerned teacher (Project Guide).
2. The Report can be prepared on **any course (subject)** under the faculty of Commerce (UG and PG).
3. The Report may be based on **primary data or secondary data**.
4. The Project Report which is to be prepared in M. Com. II, Semester IV should be based on **Survey Method** of Research.

5. The outline of the Project Report should be as follows –
 For the Research Project of M. Com. II, Semester IV (6 credits)
 The Project Report shall consist of at least **typed 75 pages**

Chapter I – Introduction and Research Methodology (5-7 pages) - Introduction, Statement of the Problem (Need of the study), Significance of the Study, Objectives of the Study, Research Methodology, Sampling (sample size should at **least 50**), Scope and Limitations of the Study

Chapter II – Conceptual or Theoretical Background or Framework (5-7 pages)

Chapter III – Profile of the Study Area (5-7 pages)

Chapter IV – Analysis and Interpretation of Data – (50-55 pages)

Chapter V – Findings, Suggestions and Conclusion (3-5 pages)

7. The technical specifications for preparation of Project Report are

- Font – **Times New Roman**
- Font Size – Main Heading – 16, Heading – 14, sub-heading 12 Bold and writing – 12
- Line spacing – 1.5 inches
- Spacing when one point over and next point start – if required single enter.
- Page size – A4
- Margin – **1” to all sides**
- Numbering – every point is to be numbered as 1.1, 1.2 etc. and sub-points as 1.1.1, 1.1.2 etc.
- Tables – every table must have title and number
- Use front and back pages. Single side typed projects will not be accepted.
- Colour Pages – only if required
- Content – for chapters, for table and for graphs & diagrams

8. Graphs should be drawn only the table includes three or more variables. ‘One variable – one table – one graph - one line analysis – one page’ format must be avoided. To analyse the data more precisely and to interpret rightly students should try to accommodate two or more variables in one table. (Variable 1 Interest rate, Variable 2 Loan Amount , Unit Price, Unit Sold)

9. The references or bibliography must be given at the end of the report. It should contain – Name of the Author, Title of the Book or Title of the Research Paper or Article, Name of the Publication or Name of the Journal and Year of the publication or issue and month of publication of journal. Generally, the references are sequenced in alphabetical order of the name of the author.

10. Every student should give Annexure at the end of the Project Report. It will include questionnaire, interview schedule, list of the sample respondents (if possible, provide mobile number, short address and their designation) and any other information or data which is important part of the study.

11. One copy of final typed Project Report should be submitted to the concerned department of the college on or before the date fixed by the concerned coordinator.

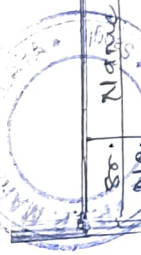
