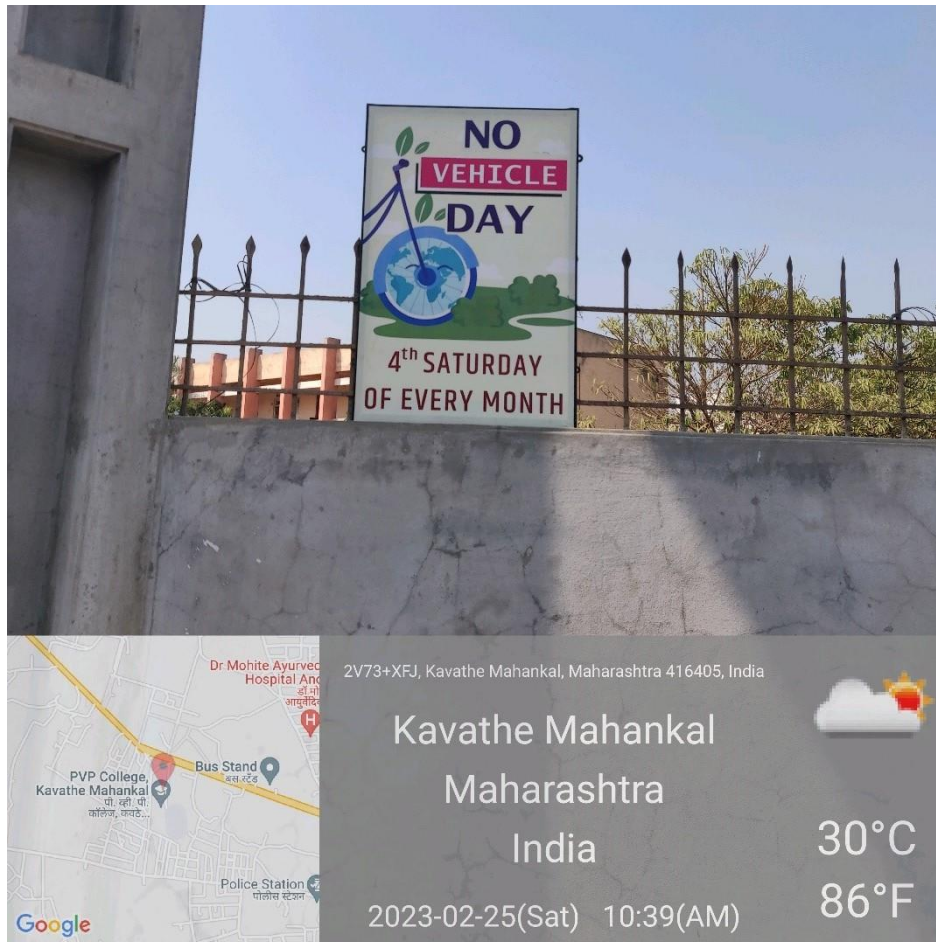

CIRCULAR

All the students, Teaching and Non-Teaching staff of the college are hereby informed that, as part of our commitment to environmental sustainability and promoting a healthier campus environment, we are pleased to announce the implementation of a "No Vehicle Day" policy starting from the academic year 2022-23.

Policy Details:

Effective Date: Beginning From Academic Year 2022-23

Frequency: Monthly (4th Saturday)

Applicable to: All Teaching Staff, Non-Teaching Staff, and Students

Guidelines:

1. On designated No Vehicle Days, all members of the college community are required to refrain from bringing motorized vehicles onto campus.
2. Alternative transportation methods are encouraged, including:
 - Walking
 - Cycling
 - Public transportation
 - Carpooling (drop-off at campus entrance)
3. Special considerations will be made for individuals with disabilities or medical conditions that require vehicular transportation.
4. Emergency and essential service vehicles will be exempt from this policy.

Objectives:

- Reduce carbon emissions and improve air quality on campus
- Promote physical activity and healthier lifestyle choices
- Foster a sense of community and environmental responsibility
- Reduce traffic congestion and parking issues on campus

Implementation:

- Designated bicycle parking areas will be expanded to accommodate increased bicycle usage.
 - Information on public transportation routes and schedules will be made available on the college website and notice boards.
 - Security personnel will monitor and enforce the No Vehicle Day policy at campus entry points.
- We encourage all members of our college community to embrace this initiative and contribute to creating a more sustainable and environmentally friendly campus.
